



CONDITIONS OF HIRE

CONDITIONS OF SUPPLY:

- All concrete pumps are supplied under the CPA terms and conditions for the hiring of plant (2021) in conjunction with the supplementary conditions for concrete pumping – copy available on request.

The main points are that the hirer is responsible for the management and supervision of the entire pumping operation, including the provision of:

- Safe access to the pump set-up position (any damage to the pump, inclusive of punctures will remain the hirers responsibility)
- Level hard standing that is adequate to support the pump (Should any additional ground support be required this will be supplied by the hirer)
- Cement to grout the pipeline / Pump primer can be supplied at £10 per pack
- Suitable concrete for the pumping operation (the addition of additives must also be suitable and must be advised at the time of booking)
- Sufficient competent labour to carry out the work and to assist the pump operator
- A suitable place to wash out the pump and adequate protection of surrounding areas
- Water to wash out the pump
- Hired in plant insurance against any and all liabilities the hirer might incur including damage caused when the boom is being operated in confined spaces

BOOKING CONDITIONS:

- Confirmations should be made by 12am the day prior to the pour. Saturday / Sunday & Mondays pours to be confirmed on Friday before 10am.
- Cancellation of the pump after 12am the day before will be subject to the full cancellation rate
- 4 Hour rates only apply under the following conditions; -Must be on site before 8am or after 1pm -Rates are only available upon request and must be pre-booked and authorised in advance otherwise 8 hour rates will apply.
- Cancellation of a confirmed booking will result in a cancellation charge of minimum hire
- Non account customers will be required to pay for the minimum pump hire at the time of confirmation by BACS. Hires exceeding the minimum hire will be subject to the balance being paid upon completion of the hire

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- We are unable to guarantee to provide a particular pump or pump operator as we need to consider the needs of all our customers as well as operator holidays and sickness. However, we will make every effort to oblige when and where we can
- We recommend that the concrete is not called in until the pump is set up on site and the operator has confirmed they are ready for concrete
- Any times of arrival are estimates and are not guaranteed under clause 16 of the CPA supplementary conditions

PUMP PRIMER:

To minimise health and safety concerns around breathing in cement dust and manual handling, we are now using pump primer to lubricate the pipeline prior to pumping. As with grout/pump priming products, it should be pumped to waste and not into the pour. If the hirer does not want to purchase TCP product, they can supply their own primer or cement instead.

Concrete is pumped at high pressure. Please ensure that all personnel are fully trained and aware of the risk/dangers associated with the use of pressurised pipelines and end placing hoses. Suitable PPE must be worn.
